Informal Proposal for Community Arts Projects for Installation in the
American Legion Hall Senior Center
Denton, TX

Community Art Project Description

The Community Art Project, run by The Art Room Denton, aims to serve and connect to the community through art projects donated to community spaces. The goal is for this project to be completed during the summer with an installation goal set in September. It will involve three separate artworks installed in three spaces within the Senior Center. The artworks will be developed by community members and artists and overseen by sub-committees in charge of each artwork development. The artworks will be unified by themes of both color and meaning that will flow through each piece.

Three Part Project

The three parts of this project are:

- **Game/Domino Room** -Quilted Mural of the Sankofa Bird
- **Hallway** -Grid-based/ pixelated mural done on wood panels of the original building.
- **Outdoor** -Un-used rectangular planters used as base for a mosaic bench incorporating original founders of the American Legion Hall, if resources left, also mosaic sculpture of the Sankofa's egg.

Basic Descriptions of Each

Game/Domino Room-Quilted Mural of the Sankofa Bird

An image of the Sankofa Bird will be creating using the color scheme: Red, Green, Yellow, White, Black. The image will be divided into individual squares. The fabric squares can be decorated using traditional quilting, fabric paints and markers, etc. The squares will then be quilted together to form a quilt/tapestry to be hung in the game room. Size options : 4'x6' or 9'x12'

Hallway Mural- Wood panels for grid mural of original building

A depiction of the original building will be created using the Red, Green, Yellow color scheme. The area surrounding the building will use a Red, White, Blue color scheme. Once the depiction is complete it will be divided into a grid (pixels) and each grid square will be produced by a different artist onto the wooden panels, using materials of their choice. These wooden panels will be mounted to a large framed piece of ply wood that can then be hung in the hallway. Size options: 6'x5' or 6'x9'

Outdoor-Mosaic Bench and Possible Mosaic Egg Sculpture.

Stoneware Ceramics will be used to create mosaic pieces that will be grouted onto the unused planters. The planters will be incorporated into a bench that will also be mosaiced. The Mosaic will depict the original founders of the ALH. If time and materials allow, a sculpture of the Sankofa's egg will be created using the same color scheme as the bench. The color scheme will be based off the color schemes used in the indoor art pieces. *need confirmation on the planters that can be used. Possibly 2'6" tall (two long rectangles 25" deep and 50" wide)

Timeline
