



Statutory Notice

Amalgamation of St Michael's C of E Infant School & Newdigate C of E Infant School

Notice is given in accordance with section 15 of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, as amended by the Education Act 2011, that Surrey County Council is proposing to amalgamate St Michael's CofE Infant School, School Lane, Mickleham, Dorking, RH5 6EW and Newdigate CofE Infant School, Village Street, Newdigate, Dorking, RH5 5DJ by closing St Michael's CofE Infant School on 31 August 2026 and offer places for its pupils at Newdigate CofE Infant School from September 2026.

In proposing a closure of a rural primary school, Section 16 of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 requires that the local authority or governing body must consult certain persons, including parents, dioceses and, where the local authority is a county council, any district and parish councils.

Surrey County Council has complied with all applicable statutory requirements to consult in connection with this proposal. At the conclusion of the Notice period, if permission is granted by the Leader of the Council, Surrey County Council will implement the proposal.
