

The Surrey County Council
(Various Roads in Bagshot)
(Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles) Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above-named Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (4), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), the purpose and effect of which will be to

- (a) prohibit any heavy commercial vehicle, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes, from entering or proceeding in those lengths of road specified and described in the Schedule to this Notice;
- (b) revoke the existing 7.5 tonne weight limit currently imposed by “Surrey County Council (Bagshot High Street and A30 London Road) Bagshot (Weight Restriction and Prohibition of Right-Hand Turns) Order 1980. NB this weight restriction will be replaced by the above-named Order; and
- (c) revoke the “Surrey Heath Borough Council (Bagshot High Street and A.30 London Road) Bagshot (Weight Restriction and Prohibition of Right-Hand Turns) (Amendment) Order 1984 in its entirety.

The prohibition described in part (a) to this Notice will not apply in relation to vehicles requiring access to premises or land in or adjacent to the roads mentioned in the Schedule to this Notice, including access for the purpose of loading and unloading. The restriction also does not apply to buses, vehicles used by the emergency services or for the purposes of essential services, works and maintenance, refuse collection, for local authority or agricultural purposes and vehicles proceeding in accordance with directions given by Surrey Police, when requiring access to the said lengths of roads.
