



Ravenglass Park Master Plan

Q. How/why did the City of Plano acquire this land?

The 38-acre site is located at the intersection of Alma Drive and West Park Boulevard and was purchased in 2010. This area is identified in the Parks and Recreation Master Plan as a future community park and trails connection for Chisolm Trail.

Q. Why does the park need a master plan?

The intent of the master plan is to provide guidance for future development of the property, in coordination with design for Fire and Police facilities and taking into consideration opportunities and constraints specific to the site, community feedback, and future operations and maintenance costs.

Q. What improvements will be provided?

The park will provide both active and passive open space with enhancements such as include picnic areas, trails, drinking fountains, seating areas, a pavilion, and additional tree plantings.

Q. When will the park be built?

The project is not funded at this time. Once we have the master plan developed, and opinion of probable cost will be made so that funding may be requested.

Q. How is the project funded?

Future funding for the renovation will be requested by voter approved bond funds.
