



BEFORE YOU GO...

PUT YOUR PHONE ON “DO NOT DISTURB”

For iPhone *(iOS 15 and later)*

1. Open Settings > Focus.
2. Tap Driving (or tap + to add it if it's not there).
3. Under Turn On Automatically, choose either:
 - Automatically (based on detected motion)
 - When Connected to Car Bluetooth

For Android

1. Open Settings > Notifications > Do Not Disturb.
2. Tap Schedules or Driving (on some phones it may be under Rules).
3. Create a rule:
 - Name it something like Driving Mode
 - Set it to turn on When connected to car Bluetooth
4. Choose what is silenced: calls, messages, notifications.

To set a custom auto-reply:

1. Inside Driving Focus, tap Auto-Reply.
2. Select who to auto-reply to: No One, Recents, Favorites, or All Contacts.
3. Tap Auto-Reply Message and enter your custom message. Use one of the options below or create your own!

1. Open the Android Auto app (or install it from the Play Store).
2. Tap Settings > Auto-reply.
3. Select contacts who will receive your message
4. Enter your custom message. Use one of the options below or create your own!

Sample messages:

I'm driving so my phone is put away. Please don't text while driving and watch out for pedestrians and people riding bikes.

Thanks for your message. I'm currently driving and keeping my phone out of reach. Please remember to drive distraction-free and watch for people walking and biking.

Behind the wheel right now, so I'm giving the road my full attention. Remember: focused driving, safe arriving!
