Proposed Provision of a Puffin Pedestrian Crossing
in Plaistow Street (B2028) Lingfield

Notice is hereby given that Surrey County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Section 23(2)(A) of the said Act of 1984, propose to establish a Puffin Pedestrian Crossing on Plaistow Street (B2028) Lingfield, the centre line of which will be 18.5 metres west of the centre of its junction with Vicarage Road. The proposed crossing will measure 6.22 metres in length and 2.8 metres in width between the studs.
