What is an Airport Master Plan?

An Airport Master Plan (AMP) serves as the long-term blueprint for an airport's future development. It provides a comprehensive vision for the next 20 years by evaluating existing conditions, forecasting future aviation needs, and identifying improvements that will support safe, efficient, and sustainable airport operations. The master plan establishes a practical implementation strategy, identifies potential funding opportunities, and evaluates development alternatives based on technical, economic, and environmental considerations. It also provides a framework for ongoing planning while ensuring the airport continues to meet local, state, and Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requirements.

How is the Airport Master Plan funded?

The Airport Master Plan is funded through an FAA Grant that funds 95% of the project.
