Victim Rights

Crime victims and witnesses have certain rights under Kentucky's State Constitution (rights afforded by Marsy's Law work in conjunction with KRS 421.500). These rights include:

- Victim/witness protection
- Financial assistance through Crime Victim Compensation
- Notification of the arrest of the accused
- Advance notification if the accused is released from jail or transferred to another facility
- Victim input
- Courtroom assistance

This information is intended to ensure that victims and witnesses of crime are informed of their rights and treated with dignity, fairness and respect. These rights keep victims and witnesses informed of emergency, protective, social, and medical services, crime victim compensation, community treatment programs and the criminal justice process. These rights also ensure that victims and witnesses are present and heard at critical stages of the criminal justice process.

- Crisis intervention
- Emergency shelter
- Support and advocacy
- Offender release notification
- Court orientation, preparation & accompaniment
- Telephone outreach
- Assistance with Crime Victim Compensation claims
- Information and referrals to other resources
- Assistance with Victim Impact Statement
