

Weybridge Town Centre Improvements Scheme

Statement of Reason

Proposed Zebra Crossings on the B374 Brooklands Road, Weybridge

Surrey County Council proposes to improve pedestrian accessibility to and from Weybridge railway station by installing 2 zebra crossings as follows: -

1. B374 Brooklands Road, Weybridge – a zebra crossing with zigzag markings; the centreline of the crossing is to be located at a point 19.75m east from the edge of the pedestrian splitter island in Heath Road. The length of the proposed zebra crossing will be 5.45m and the width of the crossing will be 2.40m.
2. B374 Brooklands Road, Weybridge – a zebra crossing with zigzag markings; the centreline of the crossing is to be located at a point 5.60m north from the edge of the pedestrian island in B374 Brooklands Road. The length of the proposed zebra crossing will be 3.75m and the width of the crossing will be 2.40m.

These zebra crossings feature together with other measures to form part of a wider improvement package that seeks to improve walking, cycling and bus travel facilities in Weybridge. The scheme has been jointly promoted by Elmbridge Borough Council and Surrey County Council. It has the support of the elected local member and Surrey Police.
