

**Surrey County Council
Proposed Traffic Calming Measures
in Weybourne Road, Farnham**

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a series of physical measures to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in Weybourne Road, Farnham.

The Flat-Topped Road Table with tapered edges will be centred 23 metres southwest of the centreline of the junction of Weybourne Road and Monkton Lane. The flat top of the road table will measure 75mm in height, 7.5m in length with 1.5m long ramps (1:20 gradient).
