This resolution states the intent of the City Council to rename Elm St. and portions of Millcreek Rd in Lebanon MO to Route 66,

**Background (problem/explanation):**

This resolution proposes that the City Council formally change the name of all of Elm Street and a portion of Millcreek Rd in Lebanon to Route 66. All property owners along the corridor were invited to a public hearing on the proposed change on January 26, 2026, with no negative comments being received. This resolution states the intent of the City of Lebanon to officially change the name of the roads (Elm St and Millcreek Rd) to Route 66 at the completion of a 30-day formal public comment period required by Missouri state law. Final council action would be at the March 23, 2026 Council meeting.
