Phase 1: Map Updated for Clarifications 6/16/2026

Continue floodplain & habitat enhancement & pavement removal throughout park.

Designate small, natural surface parking areas to protect natural resources - proposed locations.

Proposed roadside path safety improvements (pavement optional).

Planned perimeter barrier fencing throughout park.

Propose to enhance equestrian facilities: remove roofless barn provide unpaved horse trailer parking area.

Identify primary-use trail, critical connectors, & highly utilized circuit trails.

Removing former AZGF House in floodplain.

Removing structure in floodplain.

Proposed restoration of legacy pond for neighborhood access.

Proposed primary trailhead with new unpaved parking & interpretive signs.

Removing structure in floodplain.

Proposed pollinator garden with boulder seating & tree shade.

Features Not Being Offered:

- Paved Parking
- Lights
- Bathrooms
- New Roads
- Paved Roads
- Embankments / Bank Protection
