The project will also include the construction of a shared-use-path on the north side of Milestone Road between Monomoy Road and the existing Polpis Bike Path for a distance of approximately 1,600 feet. The project will make geometric changes to the Polpis Road approach to improve safety and accessibility for all users while providing an extension of the shared use path through the intersection on the north side of Milestone Road.
